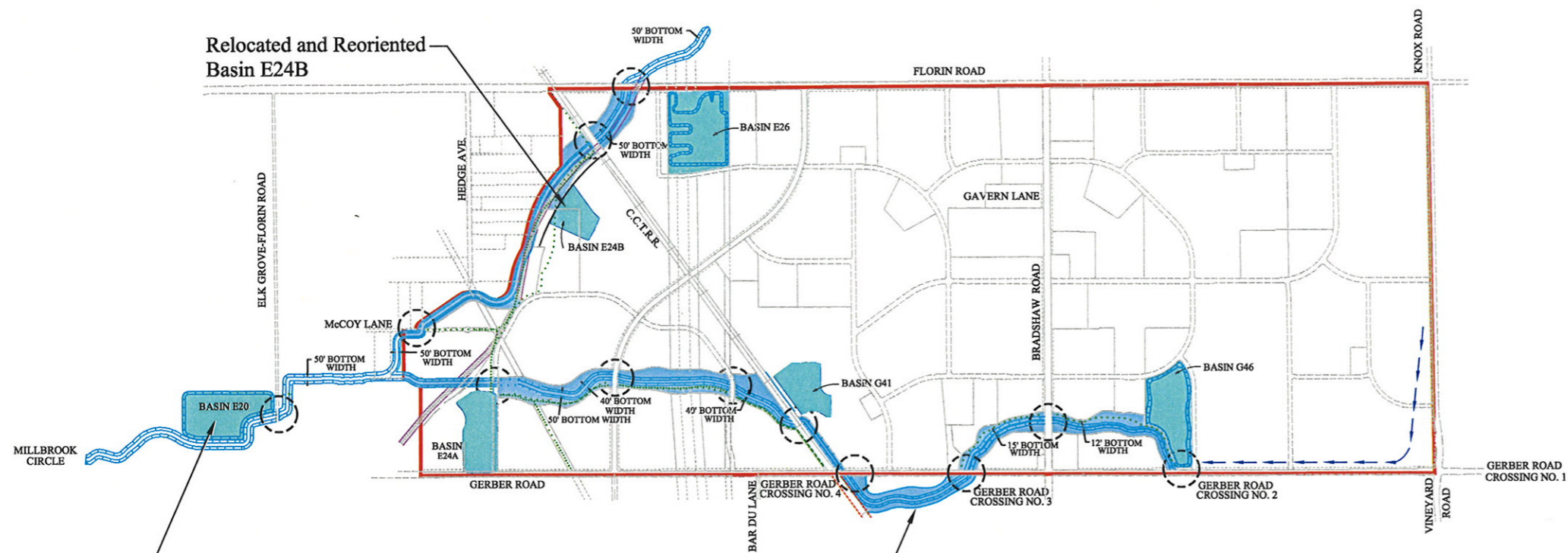

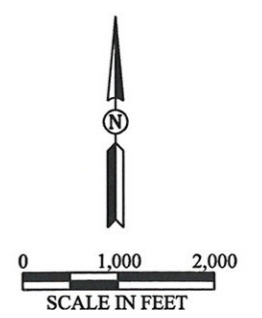

 Spill from Laguna Creek will be eliminated in the Ultimate Conditions, by drainage improvements within the Laguna Creek drainage system and not from facilities implemented as part of the Preferred Drainage Plan.
